

In accordance with Special Measures Law Article 45, Clause 1, citizens are requested to refrain from non-essential outings

■Region: All of Miyagi Prefecture

■Duration: From April 17, 2020 to May 6, 2020

- Excluding hospital visits, grocery/pharmaceutical/daily essential purchases, necessary commutes to work, outdoor exercise, and other indispensable activities for daily living, the government requests citizens to refrain from non-essential outings as a general rule.
- When going outside is absolutely necessary, please take comprehensive infection prevention measures. These include avoiding areas with poor ventilation, large crowds, and close conversations, washing hands thoroughly, wearing a mask, disinfecting objects touched by hands, grocery shopping alone, going with the minimal number of people in the least amount of time, teleworking, and staggered commuting.
- In particular, the government strongly requests refraining from entering dining establishments in busy areas, regardless of age.
- During the long holidays, it is also strongly requested that citizens refrain from non-essential travel and home visits that require entering into other prefectures.

In accordance with Special Measures Law Article 24, Clause 9, event organizers are requested to refrain from holding events

■Region: All of Miyagi Prefecture

■Duration: From April 17, 2020 to May 6, 2020

- Regardless of whether the event is held indoors or outdoors, events and parties where there are multiple participants and crowding are requested to be cancelled.

<Examples>

Parties, exhibitions, ceremonies, lectures, training gatherings, sports events, etc.

*For events absolutely necessary in maintaining daily living, please thoroughly follow infection prevention measures.
